## Job description

The Shelter Specialist empowers victims of domestic violence and homelessness by providing a safe, clean environment, and direct services to shelter residents, and assists residents with shelter needs as the arise. This position answers the hotline and provides information and referrals and is able to triage questions and assist in safety planning using a trauma informed approach.

#### **Qualifications:**

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Work experience in domestic violence, social services, human services or related field preferred.
- College course study in the areas of social work, psychology, education or related field is preferred.
- 40 hours of domestic violence training provided.
- Possess the temperament to work closely with individuals and families experiencing domestic violence, homelessness, and co-occurring disorders in a therapeutic milieu.
- Demonstrate knowledge of individual differences with respect to gender, race, ethnicity, culture, and age as well as social, economic, developmental, and environmental factors, and understands the importance of these characteristics.
- Knowledge/skills in the area of individual and family functioning.
- Ability to work flexible hours including some weekends.
- Ability to maintain the highest level of confidentiality and professionalism.
- Valid driver's license and proof of auto insurance.

- Provide confidential support to persons experiencing domestic violence and homelessness.
- Provide IDVA information and safety planning to victims.
- Actively remain knowledge/informed about social agencies in the area for possible referrals.
- Staff on-site hotline and shelter from 4:pm to 12:am
- Maintain appropriate records of persons served filing of service information and preparation of new files.
- Enter monthly service and program statistics.
- Clean rooms as they are vacated by persons served.

• Clean and organize main office.
